

Lyde Court Craft Markets – Stallholder Terms & Conditions

1. Booking and Deposit Policy

- 1.1. To secure a stall, all stallholders **must complete the application form and pay £15** via our booking form.
 - 1.2 You will be given two vouchers to use at Lyde Court. A drink voucher worth up to £5, and a food voucher worth up to £10. The vouchers will only be valid on the day of your attendance.
 - 1.3. **No refund will be given if you have to cancel your stall booking.**
 - 1.4. Stallholders will receive a confirmation email upon approval of their application.
 - 1.5. There are no exceptions to the cancellation rule, but if you cancel, we have disappointed customers and an empty exhibition space.

3. Stall Setup and Table Allocation

- 3.1. Stallholders can choose between:
 - **6-foot table**
 - **9-foot table** (limited availability)
 - 3.2. Outdoor tables are welcome but you must provide your own gazebo if required.
 - 3.3. Stallholders may begin setting up from **7:30 AM** and must be fully set up by **9:45 AM**.
 - 3.4. The market runs from **10:00 AM to 4:00 PM**, and stallholders must **remain until the closing time unless agreed otherwise**.
 - 3.5. Each stallholder is responsible for **maintaining a clean space** and ensuring all rubbish is removed.

4. Payment Handling

- 4.1. **WiFi is available** at the venue, but the venue does not guarantee its reliability, so stallholders must be prepared to accept payments via **cash or their own mobile payment methods**.
 - 4.2. Lyde Court **does not provide card payment facilities** for stallholders.
 - 4.3 Lyde Court does not accept cash payments (card only), cashback is not available at our bar

5. Product and Conduct Guidelines

- 5.1. Stallholders may only sell the products **approved during their application**.
 - 5.2. Lyde Court reserves the right to **decline** any stallholder whose products do not fit the market's theme or ethos.
 - 5.3. Stallholders must conduct themselves professionally and ensure their stall is visually appealing.
 - 5.4. Any damage to tables or venue property caused by the stallholder must be reported and may be chargeable.

6. Event Promotion and Social Media

- 6.1. Stallholders **are encouraged to promote the event** via social media and share event details with their followers.

6.2. Lyde Court may use stallholder business names, images, and descriptions for promotional purposes.

7. Liability Disclaimer

7.1. Lyde Court is **not liable** for any loss, theft, or damage to stallholders' goods, equipment, or personal belongings.

7.2. Stallholders are responsible for **their own insurance**, including public liability and product liability where necessary.

8. Force Majeure & Event Cancellation

8.1. If Lyde Court cancels the event due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g., extreme weather, government restrictions), **no charges will be applied**, and deposits will be refunded or transferred to a future market.

9. Agreement to Terms

9.1. By booking a stall, stallholders confirm that they have read, understood, and agreed to these **Terms and Conditions**.
